The webinar included a briefing on the history and activities of COSW by David N Jones as well as on the new constitution by Ramesh K. S. Nathan Chong Nee described his experience of recently joining the Board after having represented COSW at the 2024 Commonwealth Heads of Government Meeting in Samoa and described the subsequent COSW South Pacific project.
